TRF Celebrates Founder's Day

Employees of TRF commemorated the 176th birth anniversary of Jamsetji Nusserwanji Tata by organizing numerous activities on March 3, 2015.

A large contingent of TRF employees, comprising senior leadership, executives, union committee members and young employees paid homage to the Tata House Founder, JN Tata at Tata Steel Works in the morning.

This was followed by paying of homage by all employees and associates of TRF at its Works. Later in the day, Mr Sudhir Deoras, MD, TRF launched the second batch of 'Rojgar' trainees at Tata Business Support Services (TBSS) at its new centre at Ramdass Bhatta Community Centre.

Twenty five youth from the adjoining communities of TRF Colony and TRF Works will undergo a 45day employability training programme at TBSS and will be employed with them thereafter.

Most the candidates are girls and belong to the SC/ST section of the society. The earlier batch of trainees consisted of 25 youth from similar background.

In addition, four exapprentices of TRF along with the engineers of TRF participated in Tech Ex-2015 a technical exhibition held annually during the Founder's Day celebrations, at SNTI (Shavak Nanavati Technical Institute).

The TRF team displayed a working model of a travelling plough feeder for handling coke, in the exhibition.

The travelling plough feeder is an innovation as by making changes in the operation of the feeder the team has made the equipment safer and easier to maintain.

TRF employees in its Port and Yard Equipment Division also paid floral tributes to the Founder on birth anniversary.
